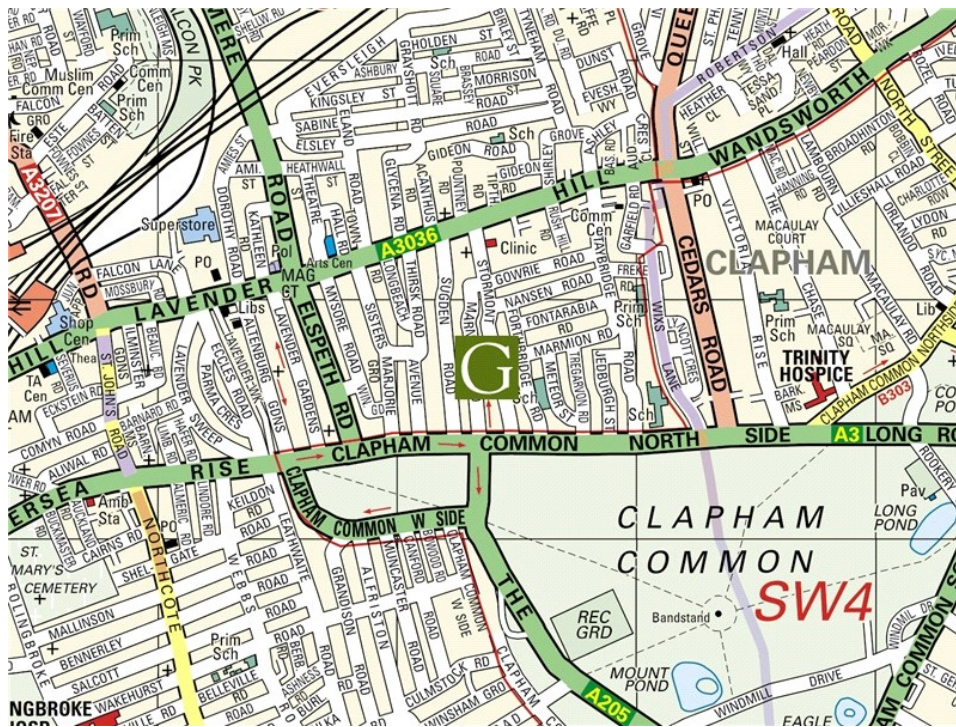

The Windmill on the Common
