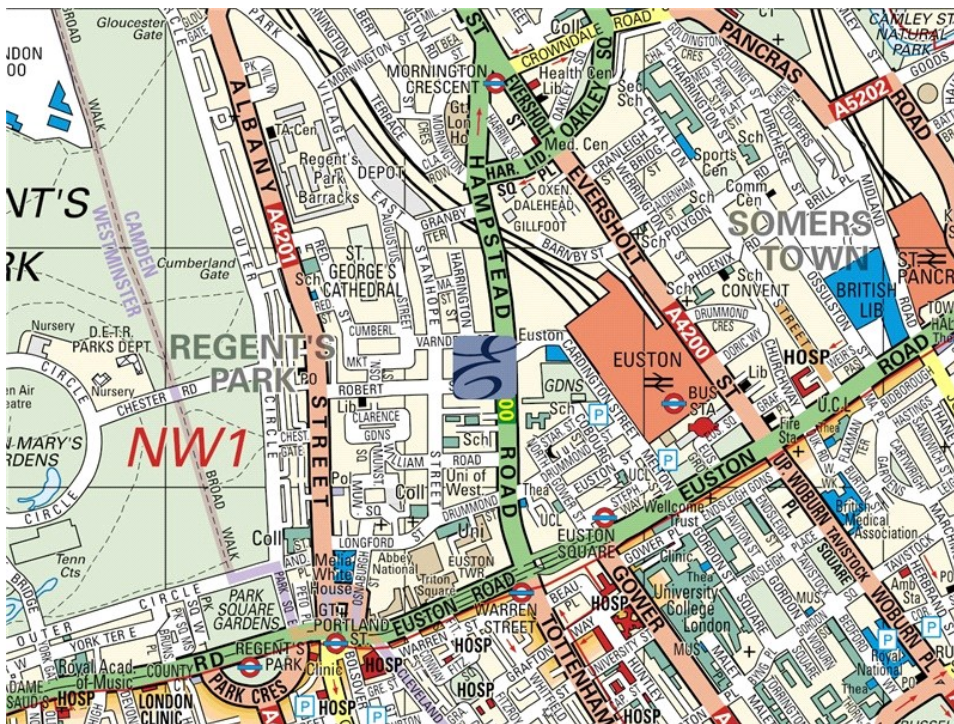

Fitzroy Square

The only square in Fitzrovia, this pretty Georgian square used to be the home to several aristocratic families including Ford Madox Brown, Virginia Woolf and George Bernard Shaw.

Gandhi

Located in Tavistock Square, Bloomsbury, the statue of Gandhi was designed by Fredda Brilliant in 1968. Mahatma Gandhi, the spiritual and political leader who led India to freedom from British rule in 1947, is represented in a meditative state, appropriate for the serene surroundings of the beautiful park

BT Tower

The main structure is 177 metres tall and has a further section of aerial rigging bringing the total height to 189 metres. Until 1980, it was the tallest building in both London and the United Kingdom but has now been overtaken by the NatWest Tower.

St Pancras

Designed by Gilbert Scott and originally opened in 1868, the station is now a Grade II listed building, famous for its impressive Victorian architecture. It is located on Euston Road in London and following a £800 million renovation, it is now one of the most striking stations in the UK.

Jazz Cafe

Since it originally opened in 1990, the Jazz Cafe has become a favourite jazz, soul, funk, dance and hiphop venue. With a long history of popular intimate gigs as well as a great value for money restaurant, the Jazz Cafe has a well-earned reputation as a cool and laid back must-visit club.
