Bon Bon Sweet Shop

Located on Bramfield Road in Clapham, this popular independent coffee shop has recently undergone a refurbishment and is now one of the favourite breakfast destinations in Clapham.

The Windmill on the Common

On the edge of Clapham Common sits this delightful neighbourhood pub, which dates back to around 1665. The pub, named after a windmill which stood nearby, can be identified in JF Herring's painting "Return from the Derby", which hangs in the Tate and is now the place to be for summer in South London.

The Nightingale Pub

This cosy and traditional Young's pub is situated between Balham and South Battersea and was built on the Old Park Estate in 1869. It is a Grade II listed building with a warm and welcoming country pub feel, having won London's first "Pubs with a Heart" award as well as The Publican's National Community Pub of the Year in 2009.

Clapham Common

With over 220 acres of greenery, restaurants, bars and even a music festival, the common is one of the most popular open spaces in south London. A favourite of a diverse range of people, from young professionals to festival-goers, Clapham Common is a picturesque and vibrant destination for all.

Clapham Common Tube Station

This London Underground station sits at the eastern end of Clapham Common along the Northern Line. The station is one of only two remaining underground stations which has an island platform in the tunnel and a glass pavillion, which was built by architects firm Aukett Fitzroy Robinson.

Northcote Road

Situated between Wandsworth and Clapham Commons, Northcote Road is a bustling shopping street, famous for the wide range of specialist shops, market stalls and boutiques. Voted London's second favourite shopping street in 2006, it is particularly popular with young professionals and families.
