Area Overview

Situated just to the north of the City, Clerkenwell plays host to some magnificent Georgian houses and historic churches sandwiched between old warehouses, many of which have been turned into beautifully presented flats. Shakespeare, Hogarth, Lenin and Pepys have all had associations with Clerkenwell and some of the old trades such as printing and clockmaking still survive. Camden Passage

Camden passage is a pedestrian area just off Upper Street in Islington, and is home to London's most thriving antiques market. Hidden down the cobbled streets, the market is famous for its unique collection of shops, stalls and hidden gems and continues to attract visitors from all over the world.

Paul A Young Chocolate Shop

Sadler's Wells

Sadler's Wells Theatre is the collective name of the 6 theatres which have been located in Islington since 1683. The theatre is dedicated to bringing the best in UK and international dance to a London audience, from contemporary dance, to flamenco, tap and family shows, there is something for everyone to enjoy.

Angel Tube

Located in Islington, this station is on the Northern Line between Old Street and Kings Cross. The station opened in 1901 and was named after the once-famous Angel Inn pub. The station is perhaps most famous for having the highest escalators in Western Europe, with a vertical depth of 90ft.

Islington Green

A small triangular green which marks the convergence of Upper Street and Essex Road in Islington. The pretty and popular park is an area of common land which roughly acts as the border between Angel and Islington

The Old Queens Head Pub

This pub is ideally situated close to Angel tube station, and offers a impressive setting with 16th Century fireplaces and a warm and inviting atmosphere. As a live performance venue, it offers regular DJ nights as well as a delicious menu, which is a welcome change from some of the regular chain pubs.
